Better Care Reconciliation of 2017

June 23, 2017

On June 22, 2017, the Senate Republicans revealed the discussion draft of the Better Care Reconciliation Act of 2017, their plan to repeal and replace the Affordable Care Act. The bill will continue to change with ongoing negotiations until Tuesday, when the bill will have to be formally filed so the Senate can debate it by June 30.
