## Frequently Asked Questions

**Question:** Are award recipients eligible for multi-year funding?

**Answer:** Annual funding cycles have a unique chronic disease focus area with a separate

application and approval process. Applicants can apply and be awarded funds for multiple funding cycles. No more than one award will be granted per organization within a single funding cycle. Annual funding opportunities will be available until

2022.

**Question:** What is the allowable indirect cost rate?

**Answer:** UIHI accepts federally negotiated indirect cost rates of up to 30 percent.
